

Introduce a Carer Terms and Conditions - October 2024

- The Introduce a Carer promotion applies to introductions received via the designated form on our website, email, telephone, and through the Introduce a Carer cards, as long as the name of the introducer is confirmed at the point of contact.
- Any approved foster carer or colleague within Calon Cymru Fostering, Nexus Fostering, Blue Sky Fostering, Olive Branch Fostering, Unity Foster Care, AFA Fostering or BSN Social Care is eligible to participate.
- A single £1,500 payment will be made to the one person who made the introduction once the new carer is panel approved.
- A single £1,500 payment will be made to the one person who made the introduction once the newly approved foster carer has had a child or young person in their care for a continuous 60 days.
- If the same person is introduced multiple times, the payment will only be made to the original introduction.
- There is no limit to the number of people you can introduce. All payments are subject to tax. It is the introducing carer's responsibility to declare this within their tax returns.
- Future foster carers must be new to the agency they are being referred for.
- Future foster carers that are recommended are subject to the usual assessment process.
- All information related to the new application is confidential and will not be shared with the person who made the introduction.
- No Introduce a Carer payment will be made to a foster carer or staff member that has resigned or submitted their intention to resign when the payment is due.
- No Introduce a Carer payment will be made to a foster carer who has left their agency or a member of staff who has left BSN Social Care when the payment is due.
- Any payment made under the Introduce a Carer initiative is subject to the final discretion of the management team.
- BSN Social Care reserves the right to withdraw or amend the Introduce a Carer scheme at any time.
